TENT RULES AND REGULATIONS
COOK-OFF CHALLENGE RULES AND REGULATIONS
SATURDAY, MARCH 21, 2015**

Welcome to the 2015 Providence Corporate Cup Run/Walk. If you ordered a tent rental, we will provide the tent set-up and take-down; you will also receive 12 chairs and 2 tables under your tent. If you ordered space only, then you will still be provided with the same number of chairs and tables. Please make sure you do not “borrow” someone else’s tables or chairs without permission. If you have paid for and ordered additional chairs and tables, they will be located under your tent or adjacent to your tent space. Those organizations that will be bringing their own tents for the race day activities are welcome to set them up on Friday evening, if they so desire. If your organization chooses to set up on the morning of the race, please be aware that access to the site will be congested because of limited access. Please be patient and courteous to all participants. Organizations will be allowed to begin setting up in the areas at 6:00 am, but not sooner unless otherwise authorized by a Providence Corporate Cup official.

Please remember that we have thousands of runners and walkers. Areas other than your immediate tent area must maintain full clearance for foot traffic, pre-race warm-ups, medical needs, etc. Please assist us in complying with these rules so we can have a safe and fun time!

We are aware parking is an issue, which we must all work around, so please make sure your representatives arrive early enough to make deliveries before 7:45 am and to park and walk to the race.

Trash receptacles will be placed in all tent areas and alongside the finish line and on the median strip throughout the tent area. The City of Baton Rouge as well as the Downtown Development District requires that NO grease, food or trash is placed on the ground. We ask that you please keep your area clean. In the unlikely event that the District determines that an area needs to be cleaned because of cooking grease spills or trash, any fees assigned by the District will be passed on to the organization where the offense is located.

Please comply with the following rules for Providence Corporate Cup tent participants:

- Absolutely NO vehicles are allowed on the grass areas or the cemented apron area of the median strips. The City of Baton Rouge landscapes and maintains these areas and we must comply with their rules on this issue!



- NO parking will be allowed on any of the street closure areas of North Blvd between 4th and 8th Streets... NO EXCEPTIONS! City Police will enforce this policy and towing will be enforced in these areas! Absolutely no vehicles are to be parked on 4th Street from North Blvd up to Florida Street. THANK YOU!
- The City Police will be given a company tent and vendor list (indicating the name of each company that reserved space). This will allow vendors or employees to set up PRIOR to the race at your tent area. Only deliveries and unloading are allowed. No parking! Vehicles will be towed after 7:45 am if not moved. Please make sure you advise your delivery personnel, cooks, etc. of these rules.
- Vehicles obstructing passage of foot traffic or Providence Corporate Cup set-up of start, finish line or tent areas will be towed!
- To participate in the cook-off challenge, you must have a company tent. Judges from Big Buddy and Mid City Redevelopment Alliance will be judging the food. They will make their presence known when stopping in. Please let the operations tent know if you are participating in the cook-off challenge.
- No BBQ pits are allowed. Propane tanks and burners are acceptable. Plywood must be placed underneath burners and pots to protect the grounds.
- The area must be cleaned and all food debris properly disposed of at the end of the race. Violators will be fined by the Downtown Development District.
